Ignorance of rules and/or procedures	Basic rules received by teams prior to event. Briefing to take place before play commences to ensure understanding of participants.	Medium	Teams to follow guidelines
Unsafe behaviour or attitude Risk of injury due to dangerous play amongst participants.	Officials to monitor conduct of players at all times. Persistent poor behaviour and attitude to be dealt with accordingly.	Low	SGO to speak with teachers as needed
Lack of appropriate first aid equipment and Experience	Schools are made aware that First Aid for their school is their responsibility.	Medium	Schools reminded its their responsibility
Poor safety awareness from participants Risk of injury increased due to lack of awareness.	Participants given safety briefing prior to event.	Medium	Schools to action
Photography consent Inappropriate use of images	Photography requires consent.	Low	Wrist bands
