

Virtual Football: Challenge Circuit (Primary)

Students complete a circuit of challenges, with each station testing a different skill.

We have kept the drills very simple so that pupils can set up and score the event themselves. If you have Leaders, they could also support the event.

There are two different circuits: one for KS1 and the other for KS2.

This event is for boys and girls, with separate results for each. There are also separate results for three age groups: Years 1 & 2, Years 3 & 4, Years 5 & 6.

There is no limit on how many children take part. We hope you will involve as many as possible! You can just enter one category (eg only Yr 1 & 2 Boys) or all six categories (boys and girls in the three age groups).

Scoring and Results

Please record your scores on the attached scoresheet (grouping by category to make collating easier).

Only the top five boys results and top five girls results for each age group will count*. This is the combined scores for all four challenges (five challenges for KS2). Only these results will be awarded points for your team. You are welcome to enter more than this on the spreadsheet but they will not count. If you wish to save time, you may enter just your top five* for each category (rather than every pupil).

*Top three for small schools (less than 100 pupils)

We still need to know how many students have taken part overall (even if you only wish to submit your top five* results). This information can be easily provided on our data sheet (attached) where you just give the overall numbers, with no names, scores, etc .
